**POLLING PLACE ACTIVITY POLICY
Adopted by the Fayston Board of Civil Authority 10/10/2018**

- No campaigning or electioneering in polling place.
- No campaign or political signs may be posted on the polling place building or placed at the entrance of the building.
- The driveway and parking area at the polling place must be kept free of signs. Campaign or political signs may only be placed on the grassy areas between the polling place driveway entrance on N. Fayston Road and the mailbox in the polling place driveway. Signs must be removed within a week after the election.
- No clothing, buttons, campaign literature, stickers, labels or other political material that reference any candidate or issue on the current election ballot(s) may be worn, placed, handed out, displayed or allowed to remain in sight while in the polling place or in the voting area, by poll workers, voters, or the general public.
- Candidates and political workers (including people conducting exit surveys) may stand on the grassy area between the polling place driveway entrance on N. Fayston Road and the mailbox in the polling place driveway. They are not allowed inside the municipal building, nor are they allowed to physically or verbally interfere with the progress of a voter to or from the polling place.
- Poll watchers must be seated at the front of the room in a designated area and may not speak to the poll workers while they are working. They must also not hinder or impede the entrance or exit by voters. The poll watcher may periodically look at the entrance/exit checklists, with the permission of the Presiding Officer.
- No photographs or videos may be taken of voters inside the polling place building unless with verbal or written consent obtained from the voter.
- No cell phone calls inside the voting area.
- No use of electronic devices inside the voting area, unless they are being used privately by a voter.
- A voter may bring a small brochure, card, or paper into the voting booth with him or her to assist the voter in casting a vote. The voter must remove the literature from the polling place after voting. Election officials will check the booths regularly to ensure no literature has been left behind.

The above polling place policy is in accordance with 17 V.S.A. §2508.
