The Fayston BCA met on 11/27/21 to begin discussion of the proposed split of the Town of Fayston into two districts. Fayston below Route 17 residents would move into a one representative district with Waitsfield and Warren. Fayston above Route 17 would move into a one representative district with Moretown and Duxbury.
