**ACTION ITEMS FOR NEXT MEETING**

**1. Public Forum**

**2. McCollough Barn Shed / Rood update**

The last chore with the shed and roof is to apply the tin. We will try to schedule a time this weekend to do this. We also discussed creating a little kiosk area on the wall of the barn under the west end of the shed from which we can distribute trail maps and information on the history of the McCollough Barn and its restoration.

**3. "Tiney Grants" final report for barn shed roof**

**5. Tenney Property**

We were wondering about the state of the Tenney property conservation. We had no new information. Ky volunteered to contact Liza and Carol said she would contact Will about the status.

**6. Fayston Town Plan Revision**

Carol will add updates and edits from last night's Planning Commission meeting and post them on Dropbox so we can review them. She said the final plan will be submitted to a regional planning commission for their review and acceptance.

**7. Fayston Town Report**

Ky pointed out that the FNRC did not submit an annual report for submission into last year's Fayston Town Report. We all agreed to make sure we don't miss this next year's report. Ky and Lisa volunteered to write a draft and will pass it over to the rest of the committee for completion and submission to the Select Board before leaving in December. We also discussed meeting with the Select Board in the fall to determine the budget line item amount for the Fayston Conservation Reserve Fund.
